Placement description:

The host candidate institution is a psychiatry clinic of a university hospital. Research activities predominantly focus on violence against women, gender bias, and cognitive behavioral therapies. The clinical work covers inpatient and outpatient clinics. Outpatient clinics are specialized in forensic psychiatry, sexual functioning disorders, addiction, and severe mental illnesses. Electroconvulsive therapy is performed if need be. Two primary psychotherapy training takes place: cognitive behavioral therapy and supportive psychotherapy.

Any limitations or specific requirements:

For research motives, the candidate must have a good level of English. Candidates willing to observe our clinical work should understand Turkish since all clinical work is in Turkish. As a team, we work in a way that is respectful and kind to each other. The candidate will be expected to behave adeptly. We have no tolerance for hate speech for races or genders.
