

Prof. Shmuel Tyano

Biography



Prof. Sam Tyano was born in Israel and graduated at the Medicine University of Strasbourg in France. He came back to Israel and opened the first closed adolescent department at the GEHA Psychiatric hospital affiliated with the School of Medicine from the Tel Aviv University. Later on, he was nominated Director of the same hospital and did it for 20 years. He came back to France in 1976 to complete his fellowship in Child Psychiatry as well as in 1993 as a visiting Professor at Lille University. He has been elected President of the

Medical Scientific Council and created the first Board Examinations for Certification in all medical disciplines. Later on, he chaired the first National Advisory Board for Mental Health and was elected President of the Israeli Psychiatric Association and President of the Israeli Child and Adolescent Psychiatry Association. Nowadays he is the Honorary President of both associations. Doctor Honoris Causa at the Bechterev Psychoneurological Research Institute in St. Petersburg, he also served as a Member of the Executive Committee of the World Psychiatric Association and chaired its Committee on Ethics and Review. He is currently a member of the EPA Committee on Ethical Issues.
