Biography



Florence Thibaut, M.D., Ph.D., is Professor of Psychiatry at the University Hospital Cochin Paris and the Paris Cité University, France. Member of the U1266 INSERM at the Institute of Psychiatry and Neurosciences of Paris. Psychiatrist and Endocrinologist, PhD in Neurosciences. Her main interests are women's mental health, sexual violence, psychopharmacology and addictive disorders. She is Member of INSERM U1266, Institute for Psychiatry and Neurosciences. She is Past President of the French Association for Biological Psychiatry (2009-). She is Honorary President of the World Federation of Societies of Biological Psychiatry (2013-). She is Immediate Past President of the International Association for Women's Mental Health (2022-) She is an EC Member of the International Neuropsychiatric Association (2013-). She is Chair of the Women's Mental Health Section of the WPA (2023-2026). She is Editor-in-Chief of Dialogues in Clinical Neurosciences (2014-) (IF 8.3). She is a Member of the Editorial Board of the European Archives Psychiatry and Clinical Neurosciences and the Archives of Women's Mental Health. She is a Member of several national and European jury boards for grants allocations. She is author or co-author of more than 300 papers (195 in PubMed), 7 books (genetics of schizophrenia and psychiatric aspects of deviant sexual disorders, neurosciences in psychiatry, sexual abuse, antipsychotics, addictions, organizational psychological medicine) and 70 books chapters (Factor H: 42-48). She was an invited speaker in many national and international meetings (524 communications including more than 160 lectures). She has coordinated several national and international congresses (WFSBP; IAWMH). She is involved in the advisory committee of the



European College of Neuropsychopharmacology, the scientific committee of the WFSBP, INA and IAWMH congresses. She was a member of the French drug agency, of the national board for neuroscience research (INSERM). She was Vice-President of the national board of Professors in addiction. She has coordinated several research grants (including national research programs in France). She is the current Chair of the Scientific Committee of the French Association of Families of Mentally-ill people (member of GAMIAN-Europe). She was an elected member of the Senat of the Paris University and of the Executive Board of its Faculty of Health (2019-2023). Recent awards: Knight of the Legion of Honour (given by the Minister of Gender equality) July 2019 Excellence in Education WFSBP award in 2017.
