



**Assoc. Prof. Gamze Erzin
Biography**



Assoc. Prof. Gamze Erzin, MD, PhD, is a psychiatrist and was a faculty member at the University of Health Sciences in Türkiye, with clinical and research expertise in environmental exposures such as childhood trauma in psychiatric disorders. She is also interested in inflammatory and oxidative stress processes in depression and bipolar disorder. She trained in psychiatry at Ankara Numune Research and Training Hospital and completed her PhD at the School for Mental Health and Neuroscience, Maastricht University. She was awarded a grant on gene–environment interaction in psychosis by the Scientific and Technological Research Council of Turkey (TUBITAK). She received the EPA Scholarship Award and the EPA Best Research Prize Award. She is a member of the EPA Early Career Psychiatrists Task Force on Communication and Publications. She is currently based in the Netherlands.
