



## **Assoc. Prof. Hale Yapıcı Eser Biography**



Assoc. Prof. Hale Yapıcı Eser, MD, PhD, is a psychiatrist and faculty member at Koç University School of Medicine, İstanbul, Türkiye with clinical and research expertise in stress-related, mood, anxiety, and cognitive disorders, as well as psychiatric conditions accompanying neurological and endocrinological diseases. After graduating from Hacettepe University School of Medicine, she trained in psychiatry at Gazi University, completed a PhD in Neuroscience at Hacettepe University, and conducted research at institutions including the University of Copenhagen and Harvard University, focusing on psychiatric genetics, mood and anxiety disorders, and the neurobiology and phenomenology of psychiatric disorders. She is one of the coordinators of the Neuroscience PhD Program at Koç University and directs the Stress, Mood, and Cognition Laboratory, where the effects of acute and chronic stress on immuno-metabo-vascular systems are investigated translationally and transdiagnostically.
