



Dr. Lieselotte Mahler Biography



Lieselotte Mahler is Director of the Psychiatric Department of the Clinics in the Theodor-Wenzel- Werk in Berlin. She is the head of the social psychiatry and health services research group of the Department of Psychiatry and Neurosciences at Charité Berlin and has been conducting research on reduction of coercion in acute psychiatry for over 10 years. She also is co-founder of the section on sexual orientations and gender identities in psychiatry and psychotherapy of the EPA and the DGPPN (German Society for Psychiatry, Psychotherapy and Neurology).

Lieselotte Mahler has published numerous articles in peer-reviewed journals (see <https://pubmed.ncbi.nlm.nih.gov/?term=lieselotte+mahler>) and several books. As a designated representative, she was involved in the development of the German AWMF guidelines for gender incongruence in adults, as well as the guidelines for children and adolescents.
