


Birmingham & Solihull Mental Health NHS Foundation Trust Birmingham, United Kingdom

Description

Secure forensic psychiatric services at Birmingham and Solihull Mental Health NHS Foundation Trust is one of the largest secure care divisions in the UK with medium and low secure units as well as a community mental health service. In addition, we provide input into local prisons. The candidate will benefit from exposure to a wide range of clinical cases in forensic psychiatry and benefit from an understanding of the criminal justice system in the UK. With close collaboration with the University of Warwick, the candidate will benefit from academic and research exposure to forensic psychiatry at the University. There is an active academic and research programme that the candidate can participate in thus enriching their knowledge in forensic psychiatry.

This placement would be best suitable for a candidate interested in forensic psychiatry. Completion of psychiatric training would be of additional value as the placement can then focus on critical aspects of forensic psychiatry rather than psychiatry in general.
