Description

The placement will focus on clinical and/or academic work in perinatal psychiatry, depending on the applicant's interest. We can organise short visits (e.g., half day or one day) to a couple of more mental health services. Applicants are required to have a strong interest in perinatal psychiatry, women's mental health, parent-infant relationship, infant mental health, etc. Previous experience is beneficial but not mandatory. This placement is suitable for trainees or specialists in general adult psychiatry with a special interest in **perinatal psychiatry**; trainees and specialists in child and adolescent psychiatry; and those interested in pursuing a PhD in this field.
