



Silvana Galderisi M.D., Ph.D. is Professor of Psychiatry and Director of the training school in Psychiatry at the University of Campania Luigi Vanvitelli (SUN), where she is also the Director of the Emergency Unit of the Department of Mental Health.

Currently President of the European Psychiatric Association (EPA), she is also Chairperson of the EPA Section on Schizophrenia, founding member and member of the Board of Directors of the European Group for Research in Schizophrenia, Chairperson of the Neuroimaging Section in Psychiatry of the World Psychiatric Association (WPA) and Chairperson of the Schizophrenia Network of the European College of Neuropsychopharmacology (ECNP). She is a Board Member of the Schizophrenia International Research Society (SIRS), European Scientific Association on Schizophrenia (ESAS), Italian Society for Psychopathology and Italian Society of Biological Psychiatry.

Her research activity has focused on schizophrenia pathophysiology, treatment and outcomes, with particular reference to the domains of cognition and negative symptoms, and their impact on psychosocial outcome.

She is author/coauthor of more than 200 papers in books and scientific journals.

She is a member of the Editorial Boards of *European Psychiatry*, *Neuropsychobiology*, *Psichiatria e Psicoterapia Analitica*, *Psychiatry Research: Neuroimaging*, *Clinical EEG and Neuroscience*, and *Brain Topography*, as well as referee for several other international psychiatric journals.
